







The chart below compares the 2018 All Grades Mathematics performance of certain disadvantaged student groups to the district's All Students All Grades score.









Third Grade ELA Performance Compared to All Grades












In 2018 Students who earn at least 25% of the credits required for a regular diploma by the end of their freshmen year are considered On-Track to Graduate.






In 2017 Students who earn a standard diploma within four years of entering high school are considered to have graduated on time.




